

Pastoral Reflection

The Apostles' Creed

Dear Friends,

The earliest of the Christian confessions was "Jesus is Lord!"

That proclamation was the conviction that, in Jesus of Nazareth, God had fulfilled all of His promises given in the Old Testament and it laid the foundation for the essential teaching of the Christian church in every time and place.

I bring this to your attention for two reasons.

First, we are now in the season of Advent as we prepare to celebrate the birth of Jesus our Lord AND make ready for His second Advent in time and history.

Secondly, we are beginning a sermon series on the Apostles' Creed which will take us, believe it or not, all the way to the end of June. Together we will look at each phrase in the creed and along the way take a journey through John's Gospel as we look at various aspects of Jesus' life and ministry.

Why the Apostles' Creed? This creed is the earliest of the creeds and confessions of our Church. It began to be formulated as early as the end of the 2nd century as believers around the "then known" world sought a unified statement that all believers could embrace. It was edited and modified for the next century or two, but finally found a form that all who called themselves Christians/Jesus followers could agree on by the middle of the 4th century.

All this to say, believers, like us, have been reciting and affirming this creedal statement for a very long time. So, when we stand and say together, "I believe in God the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth...." we are standing in the midst of a great cloud of witnesses.

In this Chimes, you will see all of the different worship, service, study and fellowship opportunities we offer at Tab this season. It is my hope and prayer that you will participate in, and enjoy, each of them as we celebrate the birth of the One we call "Savior and Lord."

I look forward to worshiping with you.


Congratulations to Sandra Reid!
