GIVING WHILE LIVING CAMPAIGN FINAL UPDATE

The Endowment Fund Trustees are very grateful to announce that we have exceeded our goal of raising funds to meet the \$1 million challenge match which expired March 31. Fifty-one Tab members matched the generous \$1 million challenge pledge and \$1 million original anonymous gift for a total of \$3,141,150 pledged over the next three years! \$2,439,500 has been received to date. Matching gifts ranged from \$100 to \$200,000. This is a terrific testimony to the generosity of our congregation and your commitment to current and future leadership and ministries of Tab and maintenance of the beautiful building in which we worship.
