PLEASE HELP OUR NEIGHBORS BEAT THE HEAT!

WHERE IS THE BIG BLUE BARREL?

Following a decision by the Mission Committee, which ended our participation in the collections of canned and dry goods for the Mid-North Food Pantry (MNFP), the barrel was removed and all remaining donations were distributed to neighbors through the Open Door Ministry Café — many of whom are also visitors of the MNFP.

Several factors contributed to this decision, including: the pantry currently receives the majority of stock in bulk through large-scale donations and discounted purchases; cash donations provide the greatest flexibility to meet the needs of the neighbors; and we no longer have staff availability to deliver the collections to the pantry in a timely manner. Rest assured, the Tab family still supports MNFP with financial donations, volunteers and Board members. We also encourage direct contributions and food donations to the pantry which is located at 3333 North Meridian Street.
