SG&D's CLASS ON C.S. LEWIS' **BOOK "THE PROBLEM OF** PAIN" WITH MARK JOHN

"I am trying to show only that the old Christian doctrine of being made perfect through suffering is not incredible." In his book, Lewis offers a rational case for the problem of pain. It is not mere reasons and arguments. Spiritual transformation begins with insight and awareness. There may be reason with no morality, but there is no morality without reason. Lewis speaks from the mind, but many of his examples arise from his own heart and life. As he has said, "Reason is the organ of truth, the imagination is the organ of meaning."
