SESSION UPDATE

At the most recent Regular Session Meeting, the Ministry Discernment Profile (needed for an Interim Pastor Search) was approved and sent to Presbytery for review. Reports were presented from the Recreation Committee regarding the hiring of a new Director, from the Human Resources Committee regarding a Pastoral Assistant, and from a Task Force regarding the hiring of an attorney to advise in legal matters if warranted.

Visits from consultants of the Center for Healthy Churches were discussed, and the Denomination Education Task Force shared preliminary plans. Also discussed was a publication entitled "Emotional Health of a Congregation During Pastoral Transition" and ideas to be implemented from it for the Congregation.
